WELCOME TO THE FIRST CORGI® Range Announcement Catalogue for 2026, where we're debuting the first batch of models that will be released between January and April. Besides the usual news though the most important thing to note about this year is that it is CORGI's 70<sup>th</sup> Anniversary!

In 2026 we're going to be working with a host of new partners to deliver some really exciting new models to collectors. We've been quietly working throughout the past several months to get things into place so you can expect link ups with relevant organisations to create products across the Aviation Archive and Vanguard ranges, as well as exciting new product releases to celebrate the release of the new James Bond videogame *007 First Light*, the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the release of *Casino Royale*, the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of *Star Trek*, and the

50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Aardman – and more besides that that we can't talk about yet!

To mark a big year from CORGI® we're investing heavily in new tooling, spread across the key areas of Aviation Archive, Vanguard and our Popular Culture ranges.

Coming over the next year we have three new tool and two heavily modified existing Aviation Archive models, five new tool Vanguard, and six new tool pop culture models, with even more beyond that in early development. We'll be revealing some but not all of these in the pages ahead, with some of them available to pre-order today!

# THE AVIATION ARCHIVE

In 2026 we are working on three brand new tool Aviation Archive models as well as investing in modifying two other existing model tools to add functionality and improve quality. While we're not ready to reveal everything just yet, we're pleased to announce a couple of those new tools here.

This year marks the 90<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the first flight of the legendary Supermarine Spitfire, so we're filling in a big hole in our range with a new tool of the Supermarine Spitfire MkV. We've taken the opportunity to go a little further with this tooling and will also be bringing something never released in die-cast before with it – early marks of the Supermarine Seafire.

Plus, we'll also be working on a new tool of the Lockheed Hudson this year as well.

And debuting for pre-order in this catalogue is the first of our modified toolings for the year, the legendary de Havilland Mosquito. We've retooled the nose guns on the FBVI variant so they are now far more detailed, and added an open bomb bay option by retooling the lower fuselage. To display the updated model, we've tooled an updated display stand cradle.

We'll have more news on the other new tool models throughout 2026, so stay tuned to our social media and Die-Cast Diaries for further updates.

# Vanguards™

We're celebrating yet another anniversary as this year sees the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Vanguards range. To mark it, we're introducing five brand new tools to the Vanguards collection. We have previously revealed the MGB GT and the Range Rover Classic, with pre-orders opening on the latter in this catalogue. Newly announced as being in development for release this year are three more Ford models – the Ford Cortina Mk2 1600E, the Ford Focus RS and ST, and most significantly the legendary Ford GT40 Mk1.

This year marks the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Ford winning Le Mans with the GT40 for the first time, but our new tooling will go beyond the race car and replicate the street legal version of the vehicle. Only 31 examples of this specification to the Mk1 GT40 were ever built by Ford at their Slough factory, but we were able to locate and Lidar scan one of those very rare vehicles to create our new tooling. We'll have updates on all of these new tools in Die-Cast Diaries in the coming months.

This example was completed on 21<sup>st</sup> July 1982 and dispatched to Skinners Motors Ltd, St Leonards-on-Sea, East Sussex. It was displayed in the dealership before first owner, a Kent-based farmer, took ownership of it.

He covered 72,000 miles before taking this car off the road and, eventually, both Escorts were purchased by a local 15-year-old enthusiast for £25 each.

He purchased it from the Ford RS dealership, Polar Service Garage, Barnsley on 12<sup>th</sup> January 1976, then registered it the following day.

It was ordered in an unusual colour scheme of Glacier Blue with Marquis upholstery, which Ford only offered for one year, and the GT and XLR option packs, the second of which included the matt black bonnet, spot lamps and Rostyle wheels.

The Capri modelled was first registered on 1<sup>st</sup> October 1974, by Taw Garages, Barnstable, Devon, a Ford main dealer. It stayed in this area, with the same family, until March 2009 when it was offered for sale via an online auction and bought, unseen, by a longstanding Capri enthusiast as it was an early car, a rare XL and had a distinctive registration plate.

The Fiesta modelled was supplied new by Ford main dealers Gilbert Rice Ltd, Sussex, and first registered on 31<sup>st</sup> January 1986. Its first four owners looked after it very well and used it sparingly. In the summer of 2016, it was offered for sale by well-known classic car dealers KGF Classic Cars, having covered 40,679 miles.

The Cortina 2.0S modelled was sold new by Kington Motors, a Ford dealership in Birmingham, in May 1977. The newly restored Cortina has created a lot of interest in the company's showroom.

Ford offered the Mk5 Cortina in several trim levels, of which GL was one, and the S Pack (for Sports) was a specification option that could be added to the customer's desired trim level, L, GL or Ghia. That means that surviving GLS or Ghia S models are rare because fewer were sold and, unlike the Mk4 Cortina, there was no separate S model.

The rally-inspired Ford Ranger Raptor Special Edition (SE) was launched in late 2021 for the 2022 model year and was something of a last hurrah for the 4-cylinder Raptor, which had originally appeared in 2019. The SE was made in limited numbers to ensure exclusivity and cost £54,086, a modest £900 more than a regular Raptor.

To start the 2026 announcements in our pop culture range, we have a brand new tool to reveal in our James Bond collection. While we may be some time away from 007's return to cinemas, 2026 nonetheless sees a major event arrive for the world's most famous spy with the release of *007 First Light*, a major new videogame created by IO Interactive. The game sees players take on the role of a young James Bond as he seeks to prove himself in the 00 programme, with the ultimate aim of attending 007 status and gaining access to one of the most exciting vehicles to appear in any James Bond media – the Aston Martin Valhalla.

A brand new tool of the Valhalla joins the James Bond collection with this range launch, featuring the advanced non-stand weaponry fitted by Q Branch. Pre-orders are now open on this model, and we'll have plenty more to show of this one as we head towards the games release at the end of May.

2026 also sees the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the *Star Trek* franchise and the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the founding of the legendary Aardman Animations. Look for updates on new models from both of these licences before our next Range Announcement in early May.

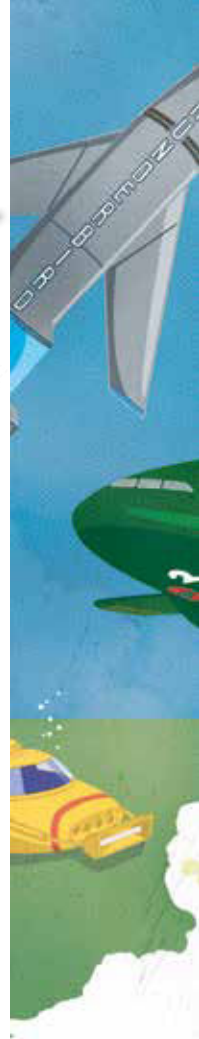
