### Bedford MK - REME Recruiting Team

The Bedford MK/MJ was the 4x4 variant of the TK, which already features as an Oxford Diecast miniature. The MK was deployed as the main medium British Armed Forces truck but was exported to many and other countries as well. First introduced in 1970 to replace the Bedford RL, it was very successful with over 50,000 produced, in many variants. From April 1981, Bedford changed the designation of the MK to MJ as the K multi-fuel engine was superseded by the J diesel engine. It was confirmed in March 2014 that, with the exception of a handful of light recovery vehicles, all British Army Bedford MK/MJ trucks had been disposed of, replaced by RMMV

HX60 4x4 trucks. After Bedford's Dunstable factory was sold in 1987 to AWD, the MK restarted production for military purposes only. This ended in 1992.

The first release of the brand new Bedford MK in Oxford's Military series appears as a REME (Royal Electrical and Mechanical Engineers) Recruiting vehicle comprising a cab with a canvas backed trailer section. It is decorated overall in a muted blue with the colour replicated in the wheels. A yellow board runs along each side of the rear of the truck printed with Royal Electrical and Mechanical Engineers in black. Red masking is applied to the cab doors which carry the highly detailed and colourful REME crest. The number plate reads 01 FH 49.

## Hillman Minx MkIIIA - Pippin Red/Pearl Grey

Oxford launched the 1:76 scale Hillman Minx MkIIIA in a two-tone caramel and beige colour scheme. For its second release, the colour scheme is a complete contrast, painted in another authentic, very regal dark red and mid grey. It is registered YDU 799 and features silver external trim and white wall tyres. The dashboard and seating are moulded in a deep red with pale grey steering wheel.

In real life, this classic British saloon car of the 1950s and 1960s was manufactured by the Rootes Group with their in-house designed Audax body, the upgraded MkIIIA appearing in 1959 as a slightly larger vehicle than its predecessors. It came with both manual and automatic transmission with the automatic option comprising a Smiths Easidrive system - the first production dual-clutch type, which was to carry it right up to 1970.


## Humber Sceptre Mk1 - Pippin Red/Pearl Grey

For the second release on the four door Humber Sceptre Mk1 saloon, Oxford have chosen a lovely rich red and pale grey colour scheme, with black interior and rich cream seating. Dating from 1964 according to the Humber's number plate - BWC 856B - the car was considered a luxury vehicle of the era but unlike some of its contemporaries, remained unchanged during its lifetime. The Humber Sceptre was a car produced by Humber (Rootes Group) between 1963 and 1976 and came as a four-door saloon or four-door estate car. The Mk1 was

based on the Hillman Super Minx, sitting at the top of the Rootes Group mid range of cars. It featured twin headlight styling and a powerful 80 bhp engine. The high level of equipment included front disc brakes, overdrive, screen washers, reversing lamp, rev counter and a full range of instruments. An automatic gearbox was to come later. It certainly had panache with lots of chrome trim, wrap around rear window, front and rear passenger quarterlight windows and stylish tail fins. It was replaced by the MkII in 1965 but remains high in the nostalgia ratings when individuality of design and performance was a key factor.

## Ford Escort MK1 - Sunset Red

Introduced in the UK at the end of 1967 and officially launched at the Brussels Motor Show in January 1968, the Mk1 Ford Escort was manufactured at Ford's Dagenham and Halewood plants. It was originally classed as a small family car but the marque was to last decades with modifications and upgrades along the way, making it one of the most appealing Fords of all times with young and old alike. It was available as a 2 or 4 door saloon as well as a 3-door estate and features included rear-wheel drive, four speed manual gear box or 3-speed automatic.

The car had a petrol engine on both the 1.1L and 1.3L models. Its contemporary styling included a subtle 'Coke bottle' styled waistline and the 'dog bone' shaped radiator grille, small features but very trendy for the time!

Our Oxford Ford Escort Mk1 is based on the 2-door version with the round front headlights and the latest release celebrates the 1100L version, decorated in bright red, registered TAJ 58K from 1971. External trim is finished in silver and black and the interior is moulded in tan with black dashboard and steering wheel.

Sit this bright addition right at the beginning of your 1:76 scale Oxford Ford Escort timeline.



## Aston Martin DB6 MkII - Volante Silver Birch

Only the second release of this beautiful Oxford Aston Martin DB6 MkII Volante, it is registered YAH 666J from 1969/1970. A replica of the rare and highly collectable two seater convertible version of the DB6, recognised by its distinctive flared wheel arches and improved features such as power steering and a 5-speed gearbox. In real life, it was destined to be the last of the classic Aston

Martin convertibles produced during the David Brown era at Newport Pagnell. Only 38 were ever made, making it one of the rarest and most sought-after Aston Martins.

The open-topped car is painted in silver with black tonneau cover, dashboard and interior flooring, deep, dark steel blue seating and sun visor and a tan steering wheel with black spokes. Exterior trim is black, silver and white. Sheer elegance!

## Mazda MX5 Mk1 (Soft Top) - British Racing Green

It's hard to believe the MX5 dates back to 1989, when it was first launched at the Chicago Motor Show. You've been treated to the open top version in bright red with Oxford's launch model. Now it has a light tan canvas hood and is painted in British Racing Green, always an

iconic colour. The interior is also dark green with pale tan seating and instrument panel. It is registered L190 RKU from 1993, the year in which the Mk1 1.6L engine was replaced by a 1.8 litre engine. Exterior trim is finished in black, wheels are silver and further detail includes the MX-5 and Mazda name printed above the rear number plate, with the Mazda badge sitting on the edge of the bonnet.

## MG Midget MkIII - British Racing Green

Our 1:76 scale MG Midget has appeared already in bright red and then a bronze yellow. Here we see it in a rich green with black interior, black tonneau cover and lots of silver trim. It is registered VRC 475M from 1973.

The MG Midget was made at the Abingdon plant in Oxfordshire between 1961 and 1979. It replaced the Austin Healey Sprite and carried over a lot of the same

features, apart from the radiator grille, MG badge and trim differences. Mechanically, it remained similar too with rear suspension using quarter-elliptic leaf springs and trailing arms. Brakes were 7-inch drums all round but changed to disc brakes at the front later. Our MkIII model in real life also benefited from improved springs, a stronger engine block and was fitted with larger main bearings. Also, motorists were treated to external door handles and wind up windows.

## Rover P5B - Bordeaux Red

The Rover Company Ltd introduced the P5 in 1958 as a series of large four-door

saloon and coupé cars, continuing manufacture, despite various company mergers and ownerships, until 1973. The unitary bodywork was styled by in-house designer David Bache and the elegant interior was

equally matched by the well-appointed interior.

The third release in the Oxford series of 1:76 scale Rover P5B saloons appears in a deep claret, complemented by extensive exterior chrome finish which extends to headlights, bumpers, radiator grille/surround and wheels. The impressive gold Rover badge is

embedded in the radiator above the number plate. The interior is black with a light beige moulded floor. Our model is registered SUT 154H, dating from 1969. Sheer class!

## Humber Super Snipe - Charcoal

The Humber Super Snipe was the company's flagship over five series of the marque between 1957 and 1967. Of all the

Humber models only the Snipe appeared as an Estate version from 1957. Big, heavy and underpowered, fired by an Armstrong

Siddeley 4 cylinder engine, nevertheless it was loved by upmarket motorists - there was even a picnic table for rear seat passengers - as well as the public sector including the Police and even taxi drivers. Here at Oxford, Humbers have appeared in various shapes and scales, and amongst those, the Super Snipe Estate has been released in several guises too, mono-coloured, two-tone, as Police and Taxi vehicles and for

its latest entrance it is registered JKT321E from 1967, the last year of production. It is painted in a muted grey colour scheme with black and chrome exterior finish. The interior features bright red seating with mid brown dashboard and black steering wheel.

## Vauxhall Corsa D Facelift - Silver Lightning

Vauxhall introduced the Corsa D in 2006 with a facelift in 2011 which gave it a new front end, newly styled grille, eagle-eye headlamps and a new front bumper. It was available as either a 3-door or 5-door hatchback and a petrol or diesel engine.

The 1:76 scale Oxford replica of this highly popular car is modelled on the 5-door version and is registered LG10 TAV.

Decorated in a metallic pale blue/silver, the interior is black throughout. Note the front and rear lights. To the rear, the light cluster is red with silver inserts and the front ones really do look like eagle eyes!

## Land Rover Defender County LWB Station Wagon - Masai Red

The Land Rover Defender County Station Wagon, introduced in the early 1980s is a versatile, rugged, and spacious version of the classic Defender. The "County" trim typically signifies a more passenger-oriented specification with features like increased seating and better interior finishes.

This time, Oxford has modelled the long wheelbase version in bright red with white roof and graduated diagonal flashes along the sides denoting the Land Rover's County image. Registered F143 SUW in 1988, note the Land Rover Defender V8 markings on the back on each side of the spare wheel. The Land Rover name also features on the edge of the bonnet

## Bedford CA Ice Cream Van - Tonibell

Previously modelled in 1:43 scale many ice cream years ago, we at Oxford are delighted to reintroduce our lovely Bedford CA Ice Cream van in the famous bright pink Tonibell livery, this time in the smaller 1:76 scale.

The story of Tonibell ice cream goes back to 1937 when Italian born Tony Pignatelli and his Scottish wife founded an ice cream manufacturing business known as Toni's in a high street shop in the Home Counties. They purchased their first mobile vehicle in 1951 - a bicycle with an ice cream container on the front. A year later they purchased a small van converted to sell ice cream

complete with chimes! Business expanded and changed hands many times over the years, including the name which became Tonibell. At its peak, Tonibell ran 500 vans and 15 ice cream parlours. Of course, the 1960s was also a peak time for the ubiquitous split windscreen CA Van, so this popular little vehicle was a prime choice as an ice cream van.

Here we see it in the bright pink colour scheme with side window hatch decorated with all the frozen delights on offer. The Tonibell cow, complete with cowbell, features all over the van, with the strap line 'Tonibell dairy ice cream.' Irresistible!

## Bedford CF - Coca Cola

The Bedford CF van was a light commercial produced by Bedford, the commercial vehicles division of Vauxhall, from 1969 to 1986. It was designed as a direct competitor to the Ford Transit and similarly, it appeared in various formats. It was equally sought after as the template for a caravanette, notably the Bedford Dormobile. It was the last vehicle to be designed solely by Vauxhall but during its day, its versatility made it one of the most popular light commercials of the day.

Here it makes its fifth appearance in the bright fun livery of Coca Cola, dressed in their signature red and white colour scheme inviting you to 'Have a Coke and a smile', with their famous logo alongside. The external trim looks great in contrasting silver and the interior is moulded in black. The number plate reads OLA 778S. The model is another great addition to the ever growing fleet of Coca Cola vehicles in the Oxford range.

You've already seen this exact model in 1:76 scale, long sold out, so here's a chance to catch the surfboard camper van in 120 scale. The VW T2 was launched in 1968, sporting a larger interior, a bigger engine and a one-piece windscreen. It also came with a number of versatile body options and you will recall its Oxford Diecast launch as a simple van in Peru Green.

The two-tone vehicle is painted a muted blue with off white roof and upper body. The bumpers and wheel rims also echo the off white colour scheme. Registered EOG 400K from 1971, our model has two surfboards on the roof, carried on a tan slatted roof rack with a silver frame. The interior of our van is also the same muted blue as the body.

## Routemaster - Shillibeer

The new 120 scale Routemaster, for its second appearance, takes on a famous livery which goes back to George Shillibeer, born in 1797, whose first horse-drawn London Omnibus took to the streets between London Paddington and the Bank of England in 1829.


Our model is dated a bit later than that - the result of collaboration between London Transport, AEC and Park Royal Vehicles. Registered CUV 191C from 1965,

the distinctive deep green body with fresh mimosa yellow masking to roof and upper deck is enhanced with a fine red line between the two decks. The interior is moulded in a brown red with a paler brown platform and handrails finished in silver. The AEC badge sits proudly in the centre bonnet minutely printed in blue and silver.

Our bus is travelling as the No. 9 towards Mortlake Garage via Hammersmith, Kensington and Charing Cross, through the heart of the City. Don't miss it!

## 3-piece Rover Set - P4/P5/P6

Our new set of three P series Rovers, celebrates key introductions of the marque across the years - and it will make an exceptional seasonal gift for the collector in your life!

The set comprises **76P4002**, the second release of the P4/90 which was released as a single model some time ago. Rover first launched the P4/90 in 1949 and here it is authentically decorated in a steel blue/light navy colour scheme, with a pale blue interior. The bold body colour highlights the wealth of silver masking beautifully, including the discreet Rover name along the side of the bonnet. The car is registered 901 HLK.

Second up is the latest livery on the **76RP5003**, the Rover P5B which we have reviewed in this issue and we think you'll agree, its rich dark red and grey colour scheme complements the other two models in this set very well. The Rover Company Ltd introduced the P5 in 1958 as a series of large four-door saloon and coupé cars, continuing manufacture, despite various company mergers and ownerships, until 1973.

The final piece in the set is **76RP001**, which was the first release of the newly tooled Rover P6 when it appeared as a single model. It is decorated in Avocado Green with black masked roof and tan interior, registered VVC 700S in 1977, the last year of production. The P6 was introduced in 1963 and was voted European Car of the Year in 1964. It had a four-speed manual or three-speed automatic gearbox on the higher powered variants.
